Free Clean Up Weekends for the Restricted Use Site (RUS) in 2017

SPRING: April 20th through 23rd

FALL: September 21st through 24th

Spearfish and Lawrence County residents are encouraged to take part in cleanup weekends. In addition to the Spearfish RUS waiving fees for residential disposal, City crews will offer City Residential pick up services for disposing large items.

The RUS is located 1.5 miles north of Interstate 90's Exit 10 just off of Highway 85 on Camp Comfort Road and will be open free of charge from 9am to 5pm on the above listed dates.

Items accepted at the RUS: trees, leaves, grass clippings, construction materials, metal, iron, appliances which DO NOT use Freon, batteries, furniture, carpet (no pad), and mattresses/box springs. **Tires without rims will be accepted for a fee. Lawn mowers, weed eaters, and any other gas/diesel powered item needs to be completely drained of all fluids (fuel and oil) before being accepted at the RUS.**

Items not accepted include: household garbage, paper, cardboard, plastic, clothing asbestos, chemicals, and hazardous or toxic wastes.

Pick up Services: Thursday and Friday of the above dates, City crews will offer free pick up services to Spearfish City residents. Disposal of large items, including appliances, will be available by calling Public Works at 642-1333, two weeks prior to each listed event. **You MUST call in to have items picked up. Calls will be accepted until 4:00pm on the Thursday of each event.** Free pick up does not apply to commercial accounts. In a case of the RUS CLOSING due to inclement weather, the following weekend will be utilized.

Truck Rentals



The City may provide a truck for City residents' use based on availability. Spearfish residents with a current, up-to-date account must come to the Public Works Office to reserve a truck and authorize the payment to be added to their monthly utility bill. Trucks are delivered and removed by City staff during normal business hours. The truck will be parked on paved or graveled surfaces only. The City will not be responsible for rutting or driveway damage. Allowed items would be branches, shingles (no paper or plastic), concrete/asphalt, dirt, or rock. The loads may not be mixed. There will be a charge for all loads. Any mixed load will result in a surcharge. For more information, please contact the Public Works Office at 642-1333.
