The Public Works Committee met at 4:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, May 11, 2021 with the following members present: Clark and Hodgs. Absent: Rath. Funding – Committee recommended to full council to approve funding the difference between the State of South Dakota's estimated project construction amount and the eligible amount of construction contract funding of \$400,000 for the Exit 8 Community Shared Use Path-Phase 1 project.
