Testing Facilities for Reasonable Suspicion and Post-Accident Testing

Reasonable suspicion and post-accident testing on employees with a Commercial Driver's License (CDL), non-CDL, or no license, will be conducted at either Monument Health Spearfish Clinic or Monument Health Hospital Lab. The supervisor who requests the drug/alcohol test will contact the testing facility and provide directions for completion of an Evidential Breath Test (EBT) for alcohol and a urine test for drugs. If the employee is a CDL holder, the testing facility will use the Alere Toxicology Services, Inc. Federal Drug Testing Custody and Control Form (Sanford OccMed Drug Testing Services). These forms have been provided to both facilities. If the employee does not hold a CDL or has no license, Monument Health will use their forms.

Follow the policies outlined in the City of Spearfish Drug and Alcohol-Free Workplace Plan and complete appropriate forms if testing is for reasonable suspicion. The policy and forms are located on the employee portal.
