Call Before You Dig!

Before starting any digging project, whether it be installing a mailbox, planting a tree or even a garden, homeowners should find out what lies beneath the ground. Did you know many utilities are buried just a few inches below ground?

Homeowners are strongly encouraged to call 811, a locating service, before starting any digging project. The locate service will then contact utility companies your area to mark underground utilities.

Hitting a line can knock out service to your home and neighborhood or result in fines, damage and serious injury! Make the call to 811 every time you dig!

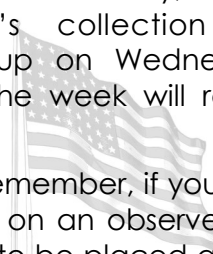
Don't be a litter bug!

Please take pride and ownership in your park facilities and dispose of any trash generated. On many occasions, picnic debris is left on tables when a garbage can is close by. Another growing problem is in the City Park parking lot on Canyon Street. Patrons are welcomed and encouraged to enjoy their lunch in this area. However, please keep garbage off the ground. Garbage cans are provided in numerous areas throughout the parks and are emptied 7 days a week during the summer season. Please "pack out what you pack in" in our parks. Take pride and ownership in your park facilities and assist in cleaning up after yourselves. This allows for parks staff to spend time on other important duties.

Holiday Garbage Schedule

Independence Day, July 4th – Tuesday's collection will be picked up on Wednesday. The rest of the week will remain the same.

Please remember, if your garbage day falls on an observed holiday, it needs to be placed at the usual garbage location by 7:00am on the correct day. Your collection times will vary on these days.
