



## *Recycling Tips for Spearfish Residents.....*

Nearly everything can be recycled or reused in Spearfish, however, going 'green' requires a little work. Here are some pointers and tips to help you understand the many and varied recycling programs available – some are free and some have small fees so please make sure to fully understand any services you choose.

**Curbside Recycling (cost)** - City of Spearfish contracted with Kieffer Sanitation for residential recycling ensuring that City residents get the lowest price available for residential recycling pick-up. Residents of Spearfish can contact Kieffer Sanitation at **605-892-4635** for details and to set up curbside service. Some of the items that can be recycled are plastics, glass, and aluminum. **Paper drop-off (free)** – The City, through Kieffer Sanitation provides a free drop off site for cardboard, newspaper, and white paper. Large bins are located on the south end of the Spearfish Recreation and Aquatics Center at 122 Recreation Lane. These are normally emptied on a daily basis. **Everyone is asked to please keep the site clean and ONLY drop-off allowed items to make sure this service continues to benefit us all.**

**Grass Clippings and leaves (free)** – can be taken to the Restricted Use Site compost pile.

**Tires (cost)** – Tires can be turned in for Recycling at the Spearfish Restricted Use Site north of town or Great Western Tires. There is a drop off fee.

**Batteries (free)** – car/truck batteries can be dropped off at the Restricted Use Site

**Oil and antifreeze (free)** – used automotive oil and antifreeze may be dropped off at the Restricted Use Site.

**Electronics (cost)** – recyclable electronics can be taken to the RUS – there is a small fee.

**Appliances (cost)** – appliances which do not contain Freon can be taken to the RUS

**Clothing, furniture and other household items** – donate to Salvation Army, Spearfish Senior Center, St. Vincent de Paul, Treasure Island and/or Goodwill. If you are in doubt as to whether your items are appropriate for repurposing/sale, please call them in advance.

**Drugs and Medicines** – you may rid your household of unwanted prescription and over-the-counter drugs at the Police Department Lobby (open 24/7!) – look for the Green bin.

**Eyeglasses** – Spearfish Lions Club has drop off receptacles in several locations in Spearfish – look for the box!!
