



'Green' Tips for Spearfish Residents

Nearly everything can be reduced, reused or recycled in Spearfish, however, going 'green' sometimes requires a little work. Below are some pointers and tips – fees do apply to some services.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

The City of Spearfish contracts with Kieffer Sanitation for residential recycling ensuring that City residents get the lowest price available for residential recycling pick-up. Residents of Spearfish can contact Kieffer Sanitation at **605-892-4635** for details and to set up curbside service.

Some items that can be recycled are plastics, glass, and aluminum. For a full listing of acceptable and non-acceptable items, visit the Residential Recycling page at www.gokieffer.com/recycling.

CARDBOARD DROP OFF

The City, through Kieffer Sanitation, provides a free residential drop off site for flattened corrugated cardboard. Bins are located at the Restricted Use Site (RUS) on Hwy 85 during business hours. Summer hours are 9am-5pm, 7 days/week. Winter hours are 9am-5pm, Mon-Sat. This free cardboard drop off is only for residential uses – commercial users will be asked to contact Kieffer Sanitation or Refuse Solutions, Inc to set up commercial cardboard pick up.

PAPER

Residents can call Refuse Solutions, Inc. (RSI) at 892-4635 for paper recycling options. Paper is also allowed in your municipal trash.

GRASS CLIPPINGS AND LEAVES

You may take your residential grass clippings and leaves to the RUS compost pile free of charge.

TIRES

Tires (without rims) can be turned in for recycling at the RUS or Great Western Tires. There is a drop off fee.

BATTERIES

Car/truck batteries can be taken to the RUS free of charge

OIL AND ANTIFREEZE

Used automotive oil and antifreeze may be disposed of for free at the RUS.

ELECTRONICS

Recyclable electronics can be taken to the RUS for a small fee. [Click here for more information.](#)

APPLIANCES

Appliances can be taken to the RUS for a fee depending on type of appliance and whether certified 'Freon removed' for refrigerated appliances. [Click here for more information.](#)

CLOTHING, USEABLE FURNITURE AND OTHER USABLE HOUSEHOLD ITEMS:

Donate to Salvation Army, Spearfish Senior Center, Habitat ReStore, St. Vincent de Paul and Treasure Island. If you are in doubt as to whether your items are appropriate for repurposing/sale, please call them in advance.

DRUGS AND MEDICINES

A free drop box is available in the Police Department lobby to rid your household of unwanted prescription and over-the-counter drugs, no questions asked. The lobby is open 24/7.

EYEGLASSES

Spearfish Lions Club has drop off receptacles in several locations in Spearfish – just look for the box!!
